Kansas Advocates for Better Care (KABC) was incorporated in 1975 as a not-for-profit, and this is our 35th year. The volunteer leaders who began our organization, originally known as Kansas for the Improvement of Nursing Homes, created it in the image of other consumer grassroots organizations of that era. We have a board of directors, chapters across the state, and paid members. KABC continues to have a volunteer board of directors, volunteers who work with us in a variety of ways from training, to elder support to fundraising, but we don't have very many of these volunteers. KABC does still have paid members and we've tiered our membership – senior, regular, business/organization, and sustaining. They have different levels of cost from \$20 to \$100. We will give any person living in a nursing home a free membership with their request. KABC has donors that give far above any of these levels.
